Compliance Statement for DRC Conflict-Free products.

Reference: Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502, reporting requirements for conflict minerals.

Conflict minerals are *Columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives; or any other mineral or its derivatives determined by the Secretary of State to be financing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country.* Metals derived from these minerals are tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold. By this definition, the only minerals of concern that may be found in Mill-Max products are tin and gold.

Mill-Max Mfg.Corp. certifies that its products are manufactured with tin and gold that is derived from material that is DRC Conflict-Free. Mill-Max provides this assurance as a result of a due diligence process that includes traceability to the source and in some cases the identification of recycled and scrap materials in the supply chain.

Mill-Max is committed to maintaining this certification through a process of monitoring and verification of its sources in accordance with the guidelines of the EICC (Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition) and GeSI (Global e-Sustainability Initiative) template.
