California Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, protects the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposures to such chemicals. The latest list of chemicals can be found on the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment website.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer.

The products manufactured by Mill-Max contain one or more of the listed chemicals in Proposition 65.

Under normal conditions of use, Mill-Max products poses no hazardous exposure to the user. Normal conditions of use are defined as the end use function the specific shape, materials, and design were intended for.
